XXII International scientific conference “Management in social and economic systems” took place in Minsk Institute of Management

17th May 2013 - XXII International scientific conference “Management in social and economic systems” took place in Minsk Institute of Management.

Representatives of 46 legal entities took part in the conference. Among them 28 representatives from the Republic of Belarus and 18 from abroad.

Altogether the program of the conference included 126 reports of scientists, specialists, PhD students and Master’s degree students, including 57 reports made by representatives of Minsk Institute of Management, 44 reports made by participants from other higher education institutions and organizations of the Republic of Belarus, 25 reports made by participants from abroad.

More than 50% of the participants have degrees and titles including: 14 Grand PhD holders, Professors, 59 PhD holders, Associate Professors.
